A draft of proposed Introductory Local Law No. 1 of 2021 entitled "A Local Law adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law §131 opting out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Town of Hume." was prepared by the Town Attorney, Richard M. Buck, Jr. at the request of the Town Supervisor. It was explained that this local law is required by Section 131 of the Cannabis Law if the Town wishes to opt out of the provisions of the State Law. Following discussion the following resolution was introduced by Chris Austin, who moved its adoption, and seconded by Pete Hopkins, to wit:

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Town Board of the Town of Hume accepts and proposes to adopt a local law to be designated as Introductory Local Law No. 1 of 2021 entitled "A Local Law adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law §131 opting out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Town of Hume." which exercises the right granted in the NYS Cannabis Law for a local municipality to opt out of the provisions

of the State Law. A copy of the proposed local law is annexed hereto and incorporated into this resolutions as though set out in full.

2. That a public hearing be held on October 13, 2021, at 7:00 P.M. at the Hume Town Court, located at 10842 Claybed Rd., Hume, NY 14745, Hume, New York.
3. That the Town Clerk, with the assistance of the Town Attorney, is directed to prepare the legal notice required to be published and to provide such notice for timely publication in the official newspaper.
4. That a copy of such legal notice be posted upon the Town Clerk's bulletin board as required by law.

Following discussion the foregoing resolution was called to a vote which resulted as follows:
